Classroom Expectations

Tardiness/Absences

- <u>A</u> A student will be considered *tardy* if not in the classroom and in your seat when the bell rings. Three *tardies* are the equivalent of one detention.
- **___**For pre-approved absences, the student is required to turn in all work in advance or on time.
- For excused absences, the student is required to complete all missed work, including class notes. Talk to Miss Miller to schedule a time for a make-up exam if you miss an exam.
