## Mathematics Classes

### Classroom Expectations

- Students will be prepared for class every day. Students will bring their textbook, notebook, calculator, and writing instrument to class each day.
- All textbooks must be covered.
- Textbooks and other materials must be kept in lockers rather than under desks or in the classroom after the class period ends.
- All students will be in their assigned seats when the bell rings, if not, you will be marked late. Completed homework will be on their desks.
- All students will respect Miss Miller, fellow students, the classroom, and school materials at all times. No inappropriate language or behavior will be tolerated. If discipline becomes a problem, the student will be assigned detention and the student's parents will be notified.
- Cell phones are not permitted to be used within the class and should remain out of sight during instruction.
- Do nothing to interfere with the teaching or learning of others.
- Eating and drinking is not permitted in the classroom. \*Water bottles are acceptable with the new water fountains\*
- Cheating will absolutely not be tolerated. Refer to Student Handbook for more information.
- Follow all Rockwood Area School District policies.

### Tardiness/Absences

- A student will be considered *tardy* if not in the classroom and in your seat when the bell rings. Three *tardies* are the equivalent of one detention.
- For pre-approved absences, the student is required to turn in all work in advance or on time.
- For excused absences, the student is required to complete all missed work, including class notes. Talk to Miss Miller to schedule a time for a make-up exam if you miss an exam.
- Students will have a two-day limit per day to turn in missed assignments due to an absence.

### **Make-Up Work**

- All homework assignments missed due to absence must be turned in when you return (depending on days absent) or a zero will be given.

### **Google Classroom**

- All assignments/notes will be uploaded daily to Google Classroom.
- Students should check for missed assignments/notes if absent from school.
- In the case of remote learning, please check in frequently for updates and assignments.

### **Extra Help**

### **Grading**
