*Rule: The silent E rule, also known as the vowel-consonant-e pattern or Magic E rule, is a phonics rule that states that when a word ends in a vowel, consonant, and the letter E, the E is silent and the vowel makes a long sound. For example: "cake" is a consonant c, vowel a, consonant k, and vowel e, so the e is silent and makes the vowel a say it's letter name -
