ENGLISH 11 SYLLABUS:

Students will complete units, with the requisite skills, on:

- Origins of the English Language-Students will learn about where the language came from and read some
 of the first
 English writings,
 such a Beowulf, the epic poem.
- Olde English and Middle English Texts Students will read selections for The Canterbury Tales and other Middle
 English texts, and will understand how they are structured and what traits they share.
- Research Papers/ Novels Students will read a novel, and then later relate the biographical research they
 do to the novel in an extended paper. Students will receive step -by-step instructions; the final draft is
 worth 300 points.
- Drama-Students will read/ watch/ perform Shakespeare's darkest play, *Macbeth*, and learn the components of dramatic literature as well as thematic concepts
- Poetry- Students will read a variety of poems by Shakespeare, Marlowe, and Pope, among others. They
 will understand poetic constructs and literary and poetic techniques
- Standardized test preparation Students in this class will be prepared for and take the Keystone Literature Exam
- Writing (ongoing throughout course) Students will journal and develop formal writing skills, as well as creating works of their own to demonstrate an understanding of material
