Pattern: Predictable
Vowel Teams Review

Rules & Examples:

1. "igh" can go in the beginning or middle of a word. **NIGHT**
2. "oa" goes at the beginning or middle of a word. **BOAT**
3. "oe" goes at the end of a word. **DOE**
4. "ee" is normally at the middle or end of a word. **BEE**
5. "ai" goes at the beginning or middle of a word. **MAID**
6. "ay" normally goes at the end of a word. **HAY**
7. "oi" goes at the beginning or middle of a word. **BOIL**
8. "oy" normally goes at the end of a word. **SOY**
9. "au" usually goes in the middle of words. **HAUNT**
10. "aw" usually goes at the end of words. **LAW**
