The Grow PA Scholarship **Grant** (**Grow** PA Grant) **Program**, administered by the Pennsylvania Higher **Education Assistance Agency** (**PHEAA**), was created by the General Assembly in 2024 to address the **growing crisis** of a declining workforce within certain in-demand occupations in Pennsylvania. This program was **appropriated** \$25 **million** to issue awards to students entering qualifying program **of** studies **across** the Commonwealth.

To prepare for the launch of the Grow PA Grant Program in the 2025-26 academic year, we wanted to provide some general information about the program. The Grow PA Grant Program provides grants (maximum award of up to \$5,000 per year) to students who meet the qualifying criteria and are enrolled in an eligible program of study. A student can receive a Grow PA Grant for a maximum of 4 academic years. Grant recipients will be required to complete their program of study requirements, work and live in PA for 12 months for each year they receive the grant; failure to meet either of these requirements will result in the grant converting to a loan that must be repaid.

Since the program was announced in October 2024, PHEAA has been engaged in conversations with key stakeholders to develop program policies. After months of development, we are pleased to announce that applications for the 2025-26 academic year will open March 13, 2025. This program will issue awards on a first-come, first-served basis, based on the received date of the student's complete application, for the 2025-2026 academic year.

To be considered for the Grow PA Grant Program, students must:

- **File** the 2025-26 Free Application for Federal Student **Aid** (FAFSA)
- Be a current resident of Pennsylvania
- **Meet** satisfactory **academic** progress for Title IV **financial aid**
- Have not earned a bachelor's degree
- Be enrolled at least half-time at an approved institution and enrolled in an eligible program of study as determined by PHEAA
- Sign a Master Promissory Note (MPN)
 agreeing to repay all funds received if the
 work requirement is not met, including
 any potential interest accrued

There are over 460 eligible programs of study or majors that lead to in-demand occupations in a variety of fields, such as agriculture, business, education, computer science, STEM, nursing, allied health, and criminal justice.
