Selection Criteria

Scholarship award winners will be determined by our board members using the following criteria:

- 1. Scholastic achievement,
- 2. Grade point average (GPA),
- 3. Evaluation of essay (minimum of 500 words), telling us about yourself and why you deserve the scholarship, and
- 4. Extracurricular activities, work experience, and community involvement.
- 5. Evaluation of two letters of recommendation from your teacher, counselor or employer.
